



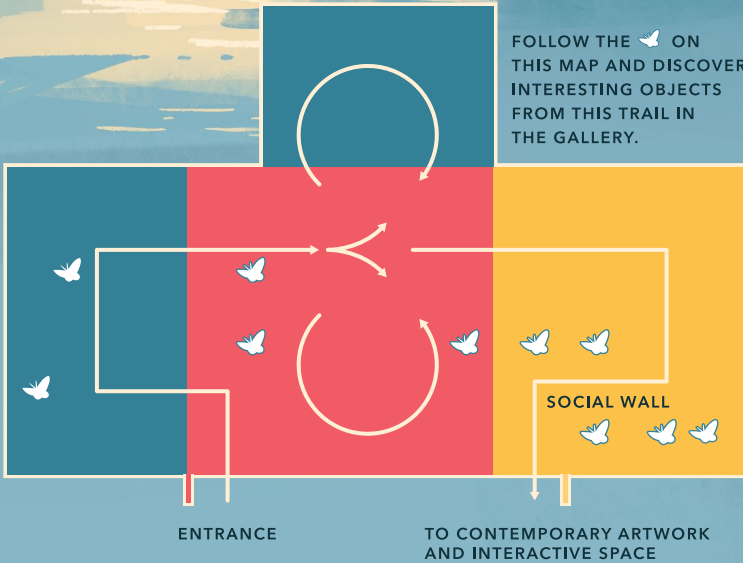

Use pencils only to avoid leaving permanent marks on surfaces, when you're in the museum. You can take photographs, but please turn off the flash.



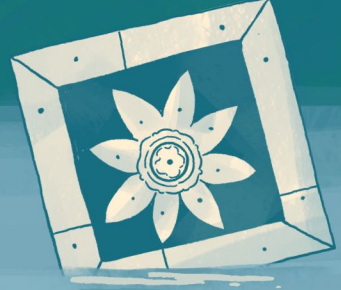

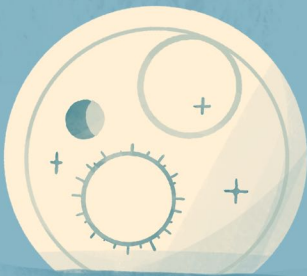
You probably use newer versions of me during gatherings. On the outside, I am painted beautifully; on the inside, delicious food is cooked!

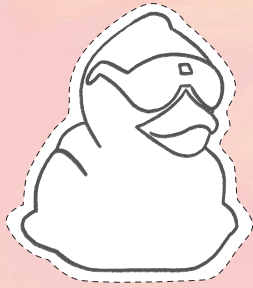

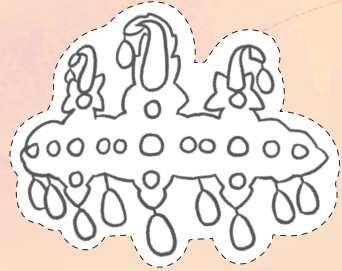
**KEBAYA WITH FLAMENCO DANCERS AND MATADORS**

Wood



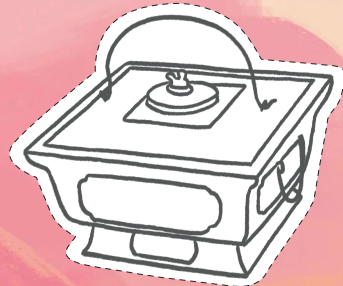
**TURBAN ORNAMENT**

Gold, emeralds, and sapphires



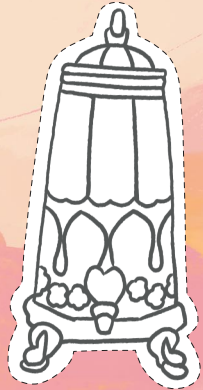
**DISH**
