Legends, up close and personal

To ignite interest in Singapore's heritage, the National Heritage Board, the National Library and the Media Development Authority have launched Explore Singapore!, which features 40 activities throughout the island. One venue is the Sports Museum at the west entrance of the National Stadium. Opened in 1983 to coincide with the 12th SEA Games held in Singapore, the museum's six galleries display some of Singapore's most important sporting treasures, including Tan Howe Liang's (above, with C Kunalan) silver won in the 1960 Rome Games, the country's lone Olympic medal. Sports buffs can sign up for the free "Relive the Kallang Roar!" guided tour from Nov 6-Dec 1 (10am-11.30am/2.30pm-4pm, Mon to Fri only) at the National Stadium and get legends like Tan and sprint ace and multiple Asian Games medallist Kunalan to guide them through the exhibits.
