SINGAPORE: Singapore and the Holy See have enjoyed 25 years of diplomatic relations.

To commemorate these continuing good ties, a joint stamp issue was launched on Thursday at the Singapore Philatelic Museum.

It is the first such joint issue between the two.

Designed by Irio Fantini from the Vatican City, the 50-cent stamp has two icons side by side - Singapore's Merlion and St Peter's Basilica.

The \$2 stamp features both the flags of Singapore and the Holy See flying side by side. - CNA /dt
