BIGGEST 'STAMP KOLAM'

Six children from St Francis Xavier Kindergarten helped to complete the largest "stamp kolam" at the Singapore Philatelic Museum yesterday.

Measuring 2m by 1.5m, it depicts

two stamps which commemorate Deepavali and Hari Raya Puasa.

A "kolam", a decorative pattern drawn on the floor with coloured rice, is often found at the entrance of Hindu homes to symbolise happiness and prosperity.

The museum will hold an open house tomorrow and next Tuesday.
