

I choose this design because my family is always kind and loving! So there is me in the middle with my parents beside me!








TASK 2 : Racial Harmony Poster





Deepavali is a celebration celebrated by the Hindus which signifies the victory of light over darkness. I have drawn a Kolam, which means beauty.





TASK 5 Family Time!	Explore the museum's fascinating artefacts with your famly. Go on a tour, snap pictures and hashtag #funwithheritage on social media


