
Examples of Respectful and Disrespectful Use of the National Flag: On Attire

Use of the National Flag image on attire (placement)

- When the image of the National Flag is used on clothing, it should be positioned above the waist.
 - The image of the National Flag should not be placed on attire considered inappropriate (i.e., undergarments, lingerie) or in areas intended to be dirtied (i.e., across the front of a mask rather than in a corner).
 - Exception: If the image of the National Flag is used in attire for the purpose of representing the nation, it should be positioned near the top and not covering areas deemed inappropriate or intended to be dirtied.



Use of National Flag image on items intended to be dirtied

1 The image of the National Flag should not be used on items intended to be dirtied (i.e., on flipflops).



Incorporating the design of the Flag in attire

1 Use of the National Flag image with text or graphics

Words or graphics used together with the image of the National Flag should be placed below or beside the image rather than above or on the image itself. In particular, any graphics or text should not cover the key elements of the image (i.e., the crescent and five stars).



2 Creative design incorporating the National Flag and its elements

The National Flag image or elements can be incorporated into other creative illustrations, but the depiction of the National Flag should not deviate greatly from the original design of the National Flag (e.g., changing the colour of the National Flag or depicting images of torn, broken or tattered Flags).
