


The Young Dr. Sun Yat Sen

Dr. Sun Yat Sen is referred to as "The Man Who Changed China". He played an important role in overthrowing the Qing Dynasty, the last imperial dynasty of China.

At the beginning of the Republic, men's costume mainly consisted of the mandarin jacket and long gown. However, Dr. Sun Yat Sen preferred the simple Western costume with front pockets where he could put his belongings. The costume was eventually given the name "Zhong Shan Suit".
