The Asian Civilisations Museum is seeking Museum Educator Guides to facilitate learning experiences for students at the museum. He/she will be involved in the following:

- Facilitate learning at the museum through storytelling, tactile objects learning, hands-on activities and tours in the museum's permanent exhibition galleries
- Engage primary school students in in-gallery conversations about displayed artefacts

Apply NOW if you are someone who

- Possess an interest history and heritage, and a good understanding of Social Studies (Pri), History and National Education curriculum
- Are familiar with MOE's inquiry-based learning approach
- Have basic classroom management skills
- Communicates well in English, both verbally and written
- Can commit to the training programme (estimated 1 week)
- Lead and facilitate learning journeys on weekdays (depending on demand from schools, each Museum Educator may be required to facilitate about 5 tours (each tour lasting about 2 hours)
- Are open to using different approaches such as the visible thinking routines, storytelling and any new approach that museum staff have incorporated into the learning package

Details on application, training and guiding:

- Application Period: October 2017 to December 2017
- Training Period: January 2018
- Guiding Period: During school terms, from February 2018 to May 2018
- ACM will schedule the Museum Educator Guides for tours based on their available dates, in relation to school requests, and will provide the relevant materials required for facilitation.

Remuneration:

• \$60 per tour (2 hour per tour)

Shortlisted candidates will undergo training by ACM's education team and docents.
