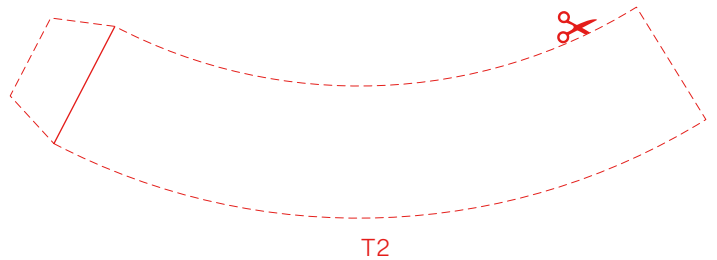
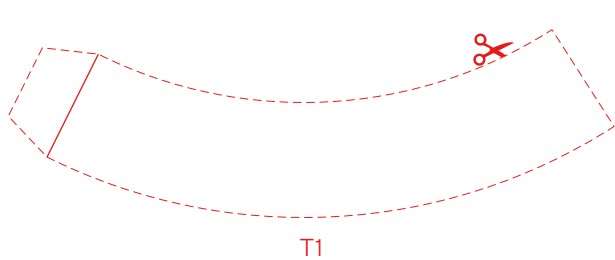




STEPS:

1. Download and print out the templates.
2. Colour and cut out the two parts of the hat in Templates A and B.  
3. Attach M to M1 with glue or tape before forming into a conical hat and use tape to secure.
4. Colour then cut out the parts on Template C.  
5. Tape both ends of T1 together. Repeat this step for T2.
6. Cut strips of about 14 cm long and 1 cm wide using construction paper, ribbon, string or crêpe paper. 
7. Lay and stick the strips evenly around the exterior of T1 band.
8. Stick T1 band on the top of the hat.
9. Stick T2 over T1 for a more decorative top.
10. Fold 10 circles in half. Then stick one half of each circle to the other half of another circle to form a ball at the top of the hat.
11. You have completed your hat!
