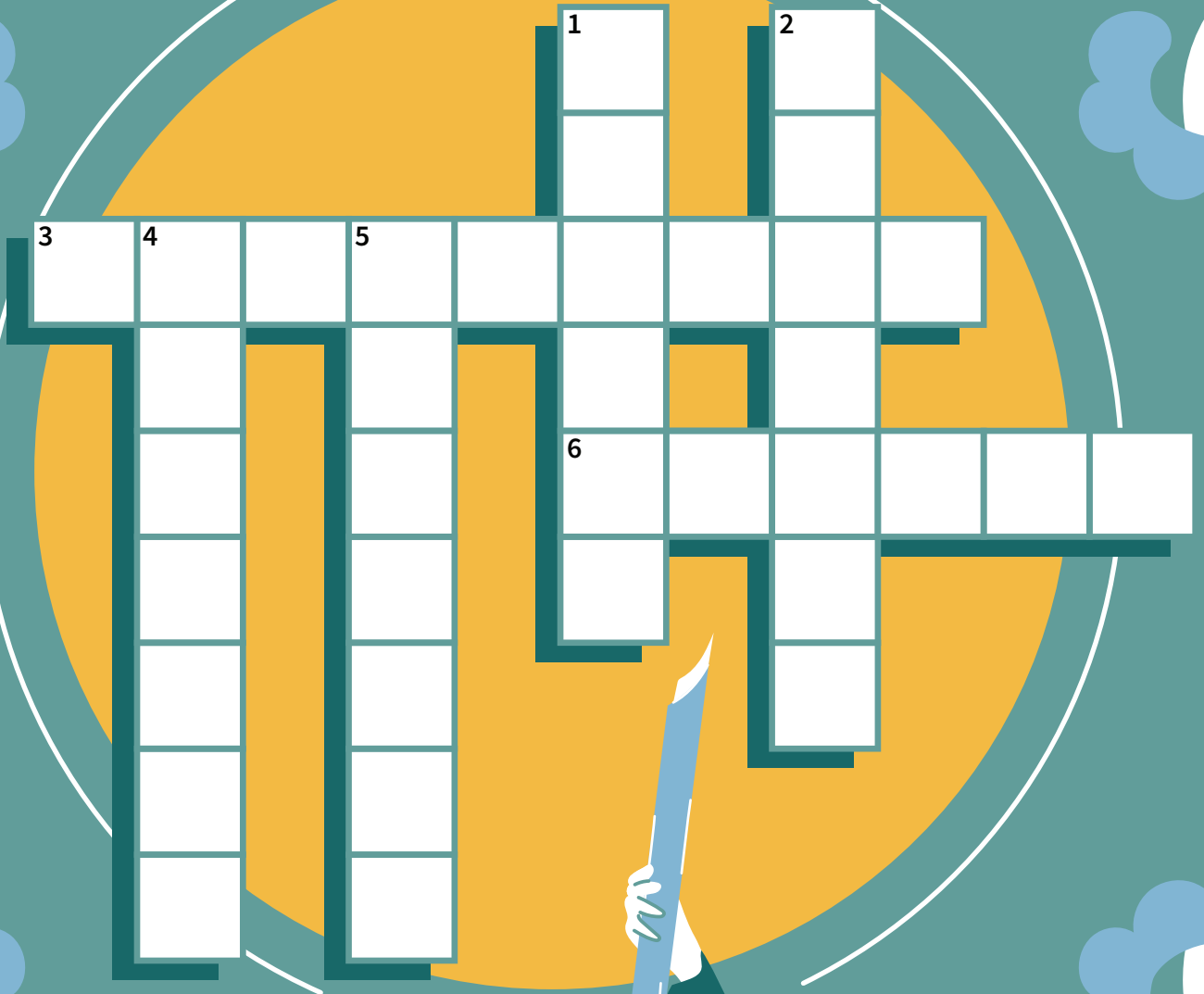

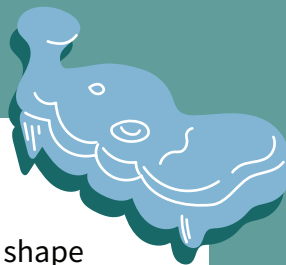

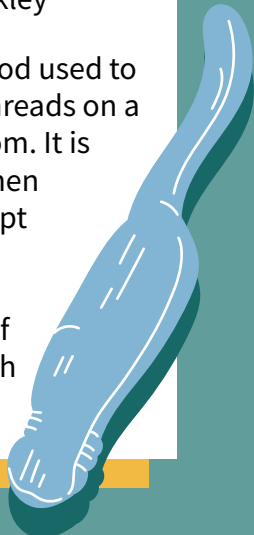
Made from blue-glazed porcelain in the shape of an elephant, this object might be found on a scholar's desk (two words).

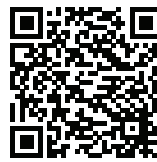
