When I am in the museum, I need to be with my group and teachers at all times. I will walk with my friends quietly and hold hands.


At the museum, I will see many other people. Some are visiting the museum, just like me. Others work at the museum.

I may also meet security guards. They keep us safe in the museum and protect the objects on display.




I may also see other groups of visitors on guided tours. These tour groups are led by people called "docents". Docents love to share what they know about the museum!
