



## BARTER MARKET

28–29 Jan, 6.30–9pm

Welcome to a trading bazaar with a twist! Barter for handmade objects, artworks, or live experiences by local creatives, all curated by Studio29, in exchange for your own objects, stories, or dreams. Inspired by the bustling 19th-century markets that used to exist along the river, our Barter Market will let you take home a new object, idea, or memory from this historical precinct.

### HOW TO BARTER:

#### Craft Items:

- Bring an item to exchange for an artwork or experience at the market. This could be a craft item, small homeware, trinket, or accessory. Used, unsanitary, and food/drinks or other perishable items are not acceptable.
- Visitors can barter up to 3 items each day, so as to allow more visitors to enjoy the activity. Each ticket given to you at the entrance entitles you to one trade.
- There will be 50 items per day, curated by Studio29, available to barter for. Items brought and bartered by the public will be sanitised before being added to the items available for trade. So, there will always be something to barter for!
- All items are only available in exchange for your trade-able items (you may only trade; no money will change hands).

#### Live Artist Booths:

- When you approach one of the booths, the artist will ask you a question and will trade your response for a live experience.
- Time with an artist is limited to 5 minutes.
