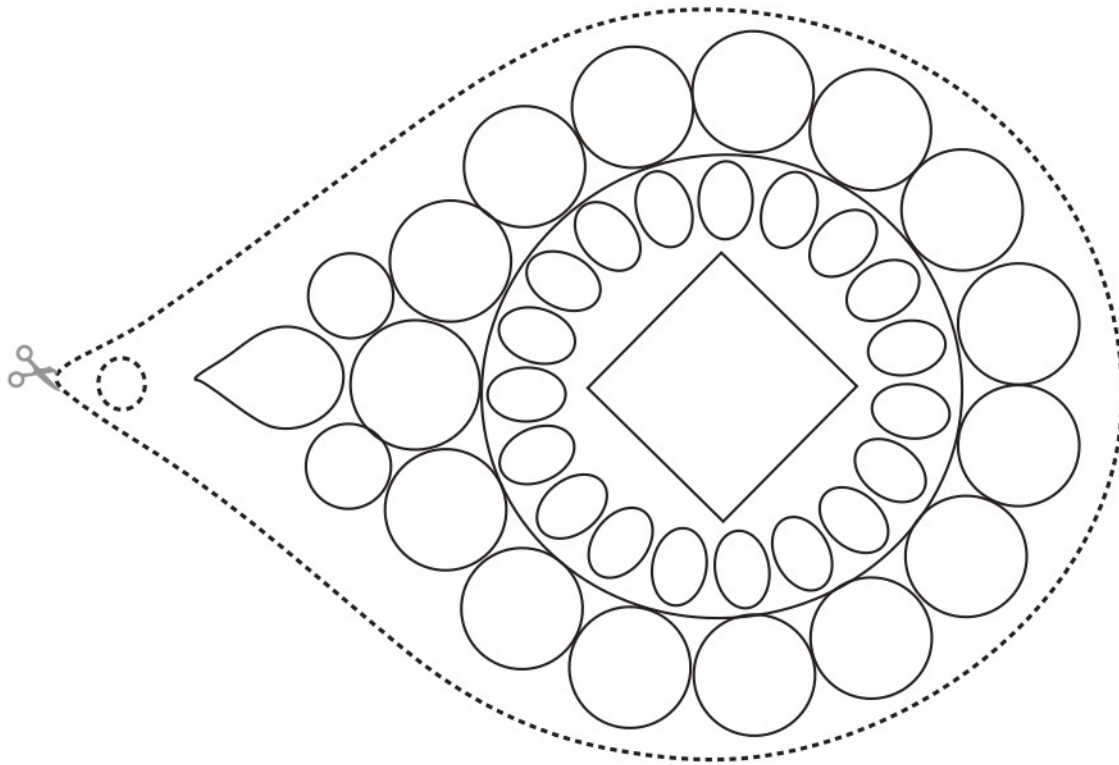


TEMPLATE A

Kolam or Rangoli Base



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Download and print out the template.
2. Cut out the Kolam or Rangoli base along the dotted lines.
3. Colour the base with markers or coloured pencils.
4. Then glue the base onto a piece of cardboard, and cut the cardboard to the shape.
5. Prepare your paper coiling strips. Cut strips of paper 1 cm wide.
6. Roll the paper strips into coils and use glue/tape to hold them in place. Tip: Use a pencil to help you roll the strips. Attach more strips to make a bigger coil.
7. Glue/tape down your coil onto the Kolam or Rangoli base, using the outline as a guide.
8. Experiment with different coloured coils to create a rainbow Kolam or Rangoli.
9. Alternatively, put some glue on the base and pour coloured sand to create your own mini-kolam or mini-rangoli artwork. Don't forget to share your creations @ACM_SG
