

## Fusion Extravaganza as East Meets West at the Asian Civilisations Museum

[5 November 2008, SINGAPORE] This weekend, visitors to the Asian Civilisations Museum (ACM) can indulge in a fusion extravaganza, complete with spectacular dance and rhythmic musical performances. Taking place from 8 – 9 November 2008, the *East Meets West* festival will also feature entertaining marionette puppetry shows, children's craft workshops and a mouth-watering local delights bazaar for a perfect weekend of family fun. Admission to the museum and all event activities is free.

Headlining *East Meets West* will be local acts *Apsara Asia*, *Teng Company* and *Mascot and Puppets Specialists*. Known for their high-energy, ethnic dance repertoire, *Apsara Asia* presents fusion dance and percussion performances, blending traditional ethnic moves and beats with modernity. Not to be missed as well is the award-winning Chinese instrumentalist group, *Teng Company*, which fuses the melodious sounds of the Chinese *sheng* and *pipa* with the Indian *tabla* and a guitar to bring audiences familiar tunes like *Dayung Sampan, La Vie En Rose* and *Flower Drum Song*.

For a good laugh, watch out for *Singapore String!*, a one-of-a-kind marionette puppetry performance with a unique local twist. Showcasing a line-up of unusual but colourful puppet characters, audiences can expect to be entertained by Chinese dancers, lion dancers and even a *getai* singer!

Apart from ongoing performances and activities, visitors will enjoy free admission to all galleries at ACM, including the special exhibition – *Neither East Nor West: Asians In Monochrome.* Visitors will also stand a chance to win prizes in lucky draws that will



be held daily over the two days, and free ice-cream and balloons will be available, while stocks last.
