Not to be missed as well are popular all-girl fusion band Mat Troi Moi, traditional flute artiste Thanh Hoa and award-winning contemporary dancers from the Association of Vietnam Dancing Artists.

Apart from the ongoing performances and activities, visitors will also enjoy free admission to all galleries at ACM, including the special exhibition – *Viet Nam! From Myth to Modernity.*
