
Spectrum of Paper

by Mademoiselle Maurice (France)


Step into a rainbow wonderland at the Rotunda and immerse yourselves in a kaleidoscope of colourful, suspended origami boats and planes!





Jeanette Aw's illustrated book, *Sol's World: Somebody to Love*, is available for sale at \$19 each at the Museum Label shop located at Level 1.




Dancing Solar Flowers


Memory Stations

by Koeh Sia Yong (Singapore)


& Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (Singapore)


