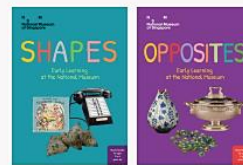













Joining our previously released Colours, Alphabets and Numbers booklets are our newest installments in the ELR series, Shapes and Opposites!

(1) GALLERY APPROACH

- Select a gallery in which to start your self-guided exploration.
- Scan the QR code to access the gallery maps. Each gallery map indicates the artefacts featured in a particular thematic booklet, that can be found within the gallery.
- Follow the map to find an artefact featured in one of the thematic booklets.
- Tick off the found artefact in the Index section towards the end of the relevant booklet.
- Repeat this for your next gallery!

(2) THEMATIC APPROACH

- Select a booklet with which to start your self-guided exploration.
- Refer to the Index in the booklet to identify the gallery in which an artefact is located.
- Check the corresponding gallery map for the exact location of the artefact.
- Visit the gallery to find the artefact and tick it off in the Index.
- Repeat this for your next artefact/booklet!

1. Orders will only be processed upon the National Museum of Singapore's receipt and acknowledgement of the Order Form from the organisation/institution/school and confirmation of the self-collection date via email. Please allow at least TWO (2) weeks for your order to be processed.
2. Organisations/Institutions/Schools can pay through electronic payment modes such as GIRO, bank transfer and credit cards. Payment instructions and e-invoice will be sent via email after the collection of your order by the National Museum of Singapore, an institution of the National Heritage Board ("NHB"). The credit terms will be 30 days from the date of the e-invoice issued by the National Museum of Singapore. There will be no refund once payment is received.
3. The Early Learning Resources booklets have been designed for use at the National Museum of Singapore, as facilitated by a teacher/parent. Please note that NHB does not provide any facilitators at the National Museum of Singapore.
4. The organisation/institution/school shall be fully responsible for any injury, loss or damage due to careless or other actions on the part of the teacher(s)/student(s) under their charge in relation to their visit at the National Museum of Singapore or use of the Early Learning Resources booklets, and NHB does not accept any liability in this regard.
