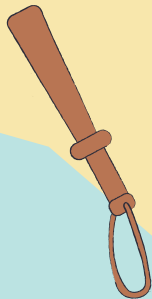
Present-day Policeman

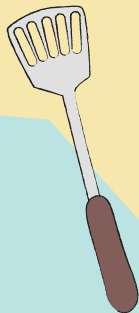
