

1. Orders will only be processed upon the National Museum of Singapore's receipt and acknowledgement of the Order Form from the organisation/institution/school and confirmation of the self-collection date via email. Please allow at least TWO (2) weeks for your order to be processed.
2. Organisations/Institutions/Schools can pay through electronic payment modes such as GIRO, bank transfer and credit cards. Payment instructions and e-invoice will be sent via email after the collection of your order by the National Museum of Singapore, an institution of the National Heritage Board ("NHB"). The credit terms will be 30 days from the date of the e-invoice issued by the National Museum of Singapore. There will be no refund once payment is received.
3. The Early Learning Resources booklets have been designed for use at the National Museum of Singapore, as facilitated by a teacher/parent. Please note that NHB does not provide any facilitators at the National Museum of Singapore.
4. The organisation/institution/school shall be fully responsible for any injury, loss or damage due to careless or other actions on the part of the teacher(s)/student(s) under their charge in relation to their visit at the National Museum of Singapore or use of the Early Learning Resources booklets, and NHB does not accept any liability in this regard.
5. Bookings are necessary for all group visits, even if the visit is a self-guided tour to use the Early Learning Resources. 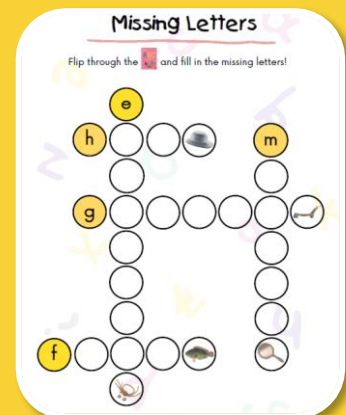

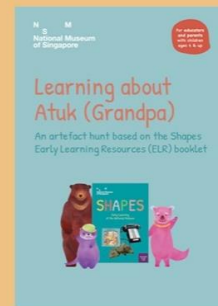
Join Dennis the Otter, Papa Sunbear and Mama Binturong on a self-facilitated story-based artefact hunt!

Choose from 5 stories – explore the galleries and solve riddles to discover little-known facts behind the mysterious artefacts. Look for the answers in their related ELR booklet!

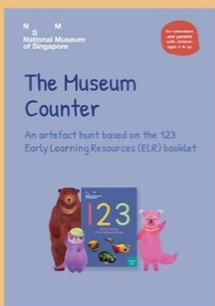

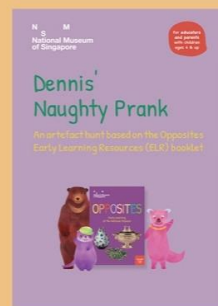

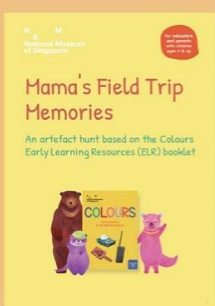
