

The National Museum of Singapore (NMS) is the nation's oldest museum that seeks to inspire with stories of Singapore and the world. The Museum's history dates back to 1887 when it opened on Stamford Road as the Raffles Library and Museum. The Museum celebrates our shared histories and deepens the understanding of Singapore and the world by engaging people through innovative, accessible exhibitions and programmes, our National Collection and scholarship. Our galleries use cutting-edge technology to present Singapore's legacy and development and offers fresh perspectives and creative storytelling to redefine the conventional museum experience.

Since 2016, the National Museum of Singapore has introduced a number of initiatives and resources in its commitment to provide an accessible and inclusive space for visitors. Families and children with additional needs who might appreciate a quieter and more relaxing environment, are welcome to visit the Museum during Quiet Mornings, when it opens an hour earlier. Spaces such as the Quiet Room and Quiet Corners provide visitors, in particular, children on the autism spectrum, with safe and soothing spaces to retreat from external stimuli.

The National Museum of Singapore is a progressive institution which champions creative experimentation by embracing innovative integrations of culture and technology. Partnerships with other cultural institutions and technology companies provide us the capacity to present history and culture through innovative technology-enabled experiences within our galleries.
