- Help students to understand and appreciate the importance of designs reflected on our Singapore stamps;
- Allow students to express their creativity in the background design they create to complement the stamp(s) and to tell the story behind the stamp(s).

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- Individual Category is opened to Primary 3 Primary 6 school students and Secondary 1 – Secondary 4 school students.
- Each student is entitled to submit **1 entry only**.
- No restriction for number of students participating per school. But each school must shortlist best entries before submitting the works to the museum.
- At the back of each artwork, the following details must be captured:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Artwork must be drawn on an A4 sized, landscape oriented, white drawing block paper or watercolour paper.
- Only **Singapore stamps** must be used in each artwork. The stamp(s) must be **unused** (mint) and each entry can use a minimum of 1 stamp or a maximum of 3 stamps.
- Only stamp(s) must be pasted onto the drawing block paper. Other objects such as stickers, plastic gems, wool etc. pasted onto the artwork, **will be disqualified**.
- Entries using computer graphics or computer designs will be disqualified.
- Color pencils, crayons, markers, watercolors, acrylic paint or oil paints can be used to create the hand drawn artwork.
- Entries deemed offensive will be rejected.
- Late entries will not be entertained.
- Singapore Philatelic Museum owns the copyright and usage rights of the artworks.
- The Jury's decision is final. Objections to the Jury's decision will not be entertained.
