Attack of the Swordfish

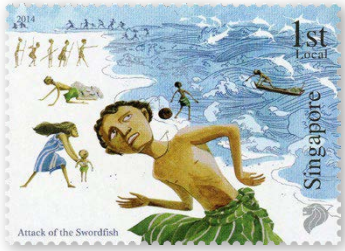
The *Attack of the Swordfish* story is illustrated in a set of 4 stamps below. Read the parts, cut them out and glue them in the correct order.

STRIP (A)



The king sent his men to the hill to murder the boy whose blood flowed down. Today, the hill known as Redhill or Bukit Merah remains as a memorial to the boy.

STRIP (B)



One day, the seas of Singapura were attacked by swordfish with long, hard and razor sharp snouts. The swordfish stabbed the helpless villagers and fishermen, and killed them violently.

STRIP (C)



The boy's plan worked perfectly! The villagers were grateful to the boy for saving their lives. King Raja was filled with jealousy and schemed to kill the boy.

STRIP (D)



The villagers asked King Raja Paduka Sri Maharaja for help but he could not overcome the swordfish. A young boy suggested building a barricade of banana tree trunks along the beach. The swordfish would become stuck and kill themselves.

Correct Order Sequence: STRIP (B) > STRIP (D) > STRIP (C) > STRIP (A)
